

RESOLUTION NO. 56,766-N.S.

AMENDING SECTIONS 2 AND 3 OF RESOLUTION NO. 55,751-N.S., ESTABLISHING THE TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION, TO EXTEND INDEFINITELY THE SUNSET CLAUSE AND ADD TO THE DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berkeley as follows:

That Section 2 of Resolution No. 55,751 N.S., is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. DURATION OF THE COMMISSION.

The life of the Transportation Commission shall be until a vote of the City Council ends it.

FURTHER RESOLVED that subsections D.15 & D.16, and subsection E. are added to Section 3 of Resolution No. 55,751-N.S. to read as follows:

Section 3. DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION.

D. In addition to the foregoing general duties, the Commission shall be empowered to do the following:

15. Consider federal and state legislation concerning transportation.

16. Consider public education regarding transportation.

E. The Commission shall work with the Planning Commission, Public Works Commission, and other appropriate commission as necessary on the City of Berkeley General Plan revision.
